SPACE

- 1 MAKE SPACES IN COMMUNITIES TO ENRICH AND BREAKDOWN BARRIERS
- 2 SPACES MUST BE RELEVANT TO EACH SPECIFIC COMMUNITY
- 3 BUILD REBELLIOUS SPACES
- 4 PEOPLE NEED TO FEEL LIKE THEY BELONG BEFORE THEY CAN ENGAGE WITH A SPACE
- 5 SUPPORT THE PEOPLE AND GROUPS USING SPACES TO FLOURISH.
